

January 1st 1866 Aules & Regulations for the Plantation Known as Greenwood To person leaving the Plantation without just cause is entitled to any wages rations or reserved pay & sho person is to leave their work during portring hours without permission under a double deduction of their pay. no person employed on the Plantation shall take inless permitted a mule Horse Hough Wagon Gear Ox or any article belonging to the Plantation under a penalty of 500 for each and every offence to be deducted from their bay Amy person caus. trouble beliveen any two or more freedmen on the Hantation or inciting them to rest or insurection will be dismissed the premises and forfiet all pay and allowences and taken to the proper authorities to be punished as the law chreets All tracking and traffic of any kind is strictly prohibited on these premises under a fine of 500 to be recovered in all cases from the aggressing party Any Laborer giving insolence to any of their Superiors or speaking or acting in any manner disrespectful to those having charge of them or to their Employer shall be dismissed the Service of the Contation and furfiel all pay and allowances All having charge of houles Marnels Houghs Gear Organ wagons De will be held to a thick account for domages or lopes All Persons having charge of Mules & Ploughs Harness De will immediately report to the Foreman any accident that may occur in order to make repairs as from as possible At night all miles will be tabled feel and properly cared for under the direction of the Foreman Houghman & He will fee that each person having Houghs or houles does attend to the team he armes according to orders or he will be held accountable for all highert. As Sickness prevails to an alarming extent no visitors are allowed unless under special permission from some anthorized person on the Plantation under a heavy prenalty Any person caugh destroying any fence tree Shoul flower shed born or outhouse or any building on or belonging to these premises will be immedi - ately token to the authorities to be prinished as the law directs

and any parent or quardian of children will be held to a Strict account for any mischief they may cause of this kind. At night all gates must be kept locked and at all other times when not in use and the Keys given to some one authorized to recieve them and there hept until wanted for use. All lights at night around the stables exceps a covered lantem is expressly forbidden and all fires eigars pipes are not allowed under any circumstances within 500 feet of a born stable or any building containing inflamable material under a fine of 25 for each and every offence As all work should cease after dock and Laborers retire to their respective Quarters no person is to visit any corn wit or any building where provision is Hoved under the pain of being suspected as dishonest and will be treated accords. All Laborers are Strictly continued to reep within the premises allowed to them. At the end of the year all fines and forfictures will be made up in a general fund to be divided among the good and faithful hands of which due notice well be Jiven
